1.5 Pitcher's Safety Screen

A pitcher's safety screen will be used:

- In Division 2 also: Seven (7)-feet tall,

Placement is centered on the pitching rubber, in front of the rubber by:

– In Division I<u>and II</u>, <u>four</u>teen (1<u>4</u>) feet.

4.9 Infielders

No more than eight (8) players on the infield dirt, includes pitcher and catcher.

RULE 6 Batting

6.3 Batter's Box

Batter will be considered "in the box" if the toes of both feet are inside the box. The chalk line is considered as inside the box.

RULE 7 Pitching

7.1 Legal Pitch

... A pitch striking the screen is a <u>Dead Ball and a bB</u>all...

8.2 Runner-For-Batter – Deleted

Divisions I and II – Manager may declare, before the game, one Player who gets a runner from home.

10.5 Field Conditions

Field conditions for the playing of games shall be determined initially by the Parma Service Department. At game time or after a game starts, the Umpire(s) working the game will decide whether the game can continue. In extreme weather situations, the League President may cancel play.

33.3 Leaving The Field

With any Runner on base, the Non-Runner Batter must exit the batters box without delay, to the right, through the first base bench, with or without their bat, without stepping in fair territory. Effect: dead ball, Batter and lead Runner are out.

34.1

...<u>On Field 5, ball is Dead and Batter-Runner and Runners are awarded two bases</u> for a fair ball, passed the sideline fence, rolling beyond the Out Of Play line before passing the outfield fence.

Three (3)One (1) home runs over the fence per game, per team. Any subsequent home runs will be singles doubles, dead ball.
